| 3. <u>RIGHT TRIANGLE</u>       | A triangle that has one $90^\circ$ angle.   |
| 4. <u>POINT</u>                | The exact location in space represented by a dot.   |
| 5. <u>RIGHT ANGLE</u>          | An angle that measures exactly $90^\circ$ .   |
| 6. <u>RANGE</u>                | The difference between the greatest number and the least number in a set of data.                               |
| 7. <u>RELATED FACTS</u>        | Related addition and subtraction facts or related multiplication and division facts. Also called fact families. |
| 8. <u>PROTRACTOR</u>           | A tool used to measure and draw angles.   |
| 9. <u>PLANE FIGURE</u>         | A two-dimensional figure.   |
| 10. <u>PINT</u>                | A customary unit of capacity that equals 2 cups.  |
| 11. <u>POUND</u>               | A customary unit of weight that equals 16 ounces.   |
| 12. <u>PERPENDICULAR LINES</u> | Two intersecting lines that form right angles.  |
| 13. <u>PLACE VALUE</u>         | The value of the place of a digit in a number.  |
| 14. <u>QUART</u>               | A customary unit of capacity that equals 2 pints or 4 cups.   |
| 15. <u>REASONABLENESS</u>      | Good number sense.  |
| 16. <u>RAY</u>                 | A part of a line that has one endpoint and goes on forever in one direction.                                    |
