| 2. <u>VERTEX</u> | The point at which two line segments, lines, or rays meet to form an angle. |
| 3. <u>TIME INTERVAL</u> | A duration of a segment of time. |
| 4. <u>SIMPLEST FORM</u> | When a fraction is expressed with the fewest possible pieces. Also called lowest terms. |
| 5. <u>SEQUENCE</u> | A set of numbers arranged in a special order or pattern. |
| 6. <u>WHOLE NUMBERS</u> | Zero and the counting numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and so on. No negative signs, decimal points, or parts that are fractions. |
| 7. <u>SUM</u> | The answer to an addition problem. |
| 8. <u>TWO-DIMENSIONAL</u> | Having length, width, area, but not volume. |
| 9. <u>SUBTRACT</u> | An operation that gives the difference between two numbers. |
| 10. <u>SIMPLIFY</u> | To express a fraction in simplest form. |
| 11. <u>STANDARD FORM</u> | A common or usual way of writing a number using digits. |
| 12. <u>VOLUME</u> | The number of cubic units it takes to fill a figure. |
| 13. <u>TENTH</u> | One of the equal parts when a whole is divided into 10 equal parts. |
| 14. <u>UNIT FRACTION</u> | A fraction that has 1 as its numerator. |
| 15. <u>SECOND</u> | One sixtieth of a minute. There are 60 of them in 1 minute. |
| 16. <u>WEIGHT</u> | The measure of how heavy something is. |
| 17. <u>UNLIKE DENOMINATORS</u> | Denominators that are not equal. |
| 18. <u>SQUARE UNIT</u> | A unit, such as square centimeter or square inch, used to measure area. |
