| 2. <u>ESTIMATE</u> | To find a number close to an exact amount. |
| 3. <u>EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS</u> | Fractions that have the same value. |
| 4. <u>FRACTION</u> | A way to describe a part of a whole or a part of a group by using equal parts. |
| 5. <u>EQUAL</u> | Having the same value. |
| 6. <u>EXPANDED FORM</u> | A way to write numbers that shows the place value of each digit. |
| 7. <u>ENDPOINT</u> | A point at either end of a line segment, or a point at one end of a ray. |
| 8. <u>FACTORS</u> | The whole numbers that are multiplied to get a product. |
| 9. <u>FUNCTION TABLE</u> | A table that lists pairs of numbers that follow a rule. |
| 10. <u>DIVISOR</u> | The number by which another number is divided. |
| 11. <u>FACT FAMILY</u> | A group of related facts that use the same numbers. Also called related facts. |
| 12. <u>GREATER THAN</u> | Used to compare two numbers when the first number is larger than the second number. |
| 13. <u>GRAM</u> | The standard unit of mass in the metric system. |
| 14. <u>EQUATION</u> | A mathematical sentence with an equals sign. The amount on one side of the equals sign has the same value as the amount on the other side. |
| 15. <u>GALLON</u> | A customary unit of capacity that equals 4 quarts. |
| 16. <u>EXPRESSION</u> | A mathematical phrase without an equal sign. |
| 17. <u>FOOT</u> | A customary unit of length that equals 12 inches. |
| 18. <u>FACTOR PAIRS</u> | A set of two whole numbers that when multiplied will result in a given product. |
