| 2. <u>INVERSE OPERATIONS</u> | Operations that undo each other. |
| 3. <u>INTERSECTING LINES</u> | Lines that cross at a point. |
| 4. <u>IMPROPER FRACTION</u> | A term for a fraction whose numerator is greater than or equal to its denominator. |
| 5. <u>MASS</u> | The amount of matter in an object. |
| 6. <u>HUNDREDTH</u> | One of the equal parts when a whole is divided into 100 equal parts. |
| 7. <u>HOURL</u> | A unit of time that equals 60 minutes. |
| 8. <u>LINE</u> | A set of connected points continuing without end in both directions |
| 9. <u>LIKE DENOMINATORS</u> | Denominators in two or more fractions that are the same. |
| 10. <u>LINE PLOT</u> | A diagram showing frequency of data on a number line |
| 11. <u>LENGTH</u> | How long something is. The distance from one point to another. Measured in units such as inches, feet, centimeters, etc. |
| 12. <u>LITER</u> | The basic unit of capacity in the metric system. |
| 13. <u>LESS THAN</u> | A comparison made when the first number is smaller than the second number. |
| 14. <u>LINE OF SYMMETRY</u> | A line that divides a figure into two congruent halves that are mirror images of each other. |
| 15. <u>LINE SEGMENT</u> | A part of a line with two endpoints. |
| 16. <u>INCH</u> | A customary unit of length. There of 12 of these in 1 foot. |
| 17. <u>LOWEST TERMS</u> | A fraction expressed in simplest form. The numerator and denominator have no factor in common except 1. |
| 18. <u>KILOGRAM</u> | A metric unit of mass equal to 1000 grams. |
