10. factors The whole numbers that are multiplied to get a product.

11. factor pairs A set of two whole numbers that when multiplied will result in a given

product.

12. foot A customary unit of length that equals 12 inches.

13. formula A rule that is written as an equation.

14. fraction A way to describe a part of a whole or a part of a group by using equal

parts.

15. function table A table that lists pairs of numbers that follow a rule.

16. gallon A customary unit of capacity that equals 4 quarts.

17. gram The standard unit of mass in the metric system.

18. greater than Used to compare two numbers when the first number is larger than the

second number.
