| 1. divisor              | The number by which another number is divided.   |
| 2. endpoint             | A point at either end of a line segment, or a point at one end of a ray.   |
| 3. equal                | Having the same value.   |
| 4. equation             | A mathematical sentence with an equals sign. The amount on one side of the equals sign has the same value as the amount on the other side. |
| 5. equivalent fractions | Fractions that have the same value.  |
| 6. estimate             | To find a number close to an exact amount.   |
| 7. expanded form        | A way to write numbers that shows the place value of each digit.   |
| 8. expression           | A mathematical phrase without an equal sign.   |
| 9. fact family          | A group of related facts that use the same numbers. Also called related facts.   |
| 10. factors             | The whole numbers that are multiplied to get a product.  |
| 11. factor pairs        | A set of two whole numbers that when multiplied will result in a given product.  |
| 12. foot                | A customary unit of length that equals 12 inches.  |
| 13. formula             | A rule that is written as an equation.   |
| 14. fraction            | A way to describe a part of a whole or a part of a group by using equal parts.   |
| 15. function table      | A table that lists pairs of numbers that follow a rule.  |
| 16. gallon              | A customary unit of capacity that equals 4 quarts.   |
| 17. gram                | The standard unit of mass in the metric system.  |
| 18. greater than        | Used to compare two numbers when the first number is larger than the second number.  |
