1. second	One sixtieth of a minute. There are 60 of them in 1 minute.
2. sequence	A set of numbers arranged in a special order or pattern.
3. simplest form	When a fraction is expressed with the fewest possible pieces. Also called lowest terms.
4. simplify	To express a fraction in simplest form.
5. square unit	A unit, such as square centimeter or square inch, used to measure area.
6. standard form	A common or usual way of writing a number using digits.
7. subtract	An operation that gives the difference between two numbers.
8. sum	The answer to an addition problem.
9. tenth	One of the equal parts when a whole is divided into 10 equal parts.
10. time interval	A duration of a segment of time.
11. two-dimensional	Having length, width, area, but not volume.
12. unit fraction	A fraction that has 1 as its numerator.
13. unlike denominators	Denominators that are not equal.
14. variable	A letter or symbol that represents a number.
15. vertex	The point at which two line segments, lines, or rays meet to form an angle.
16. volume	The number of cubic units it takes to fill a figure.
17. weight	The measure of how heavy something is.
18. whole numbers	Zero and the counting numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and so on. No negative signs, decimal points, or parts that are fractions.
