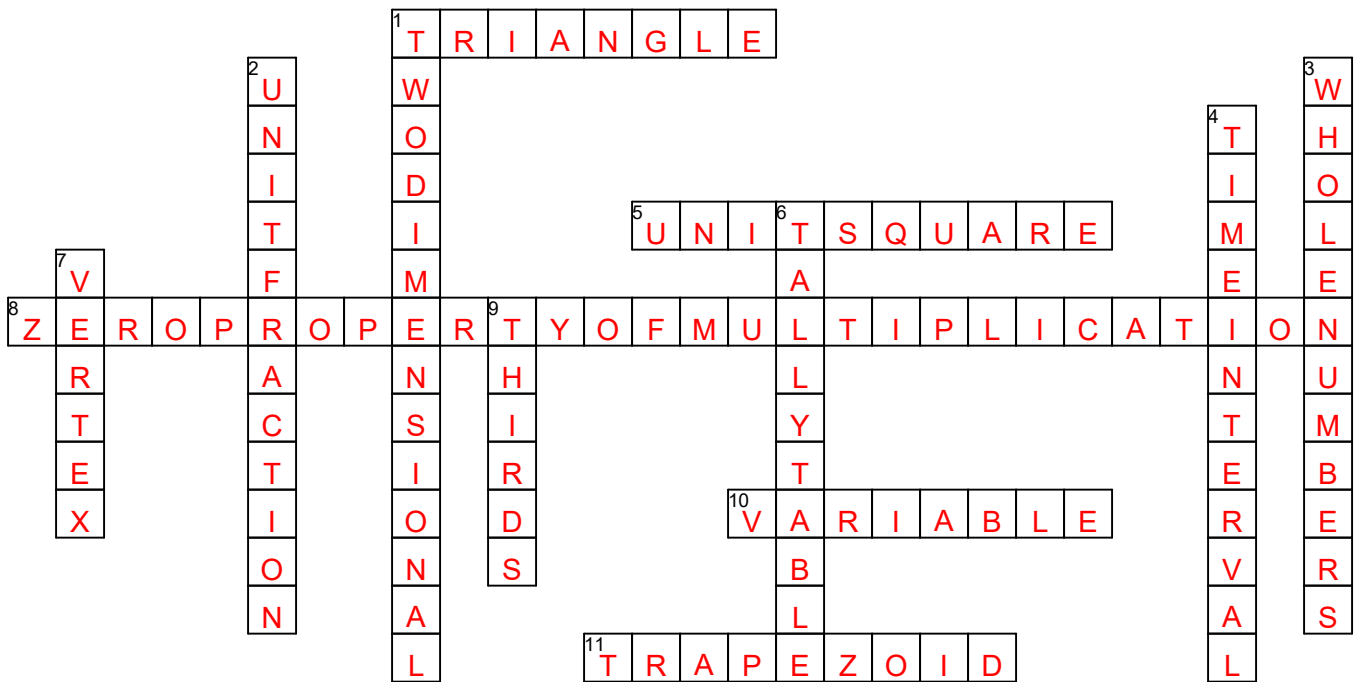


3rd Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 20
