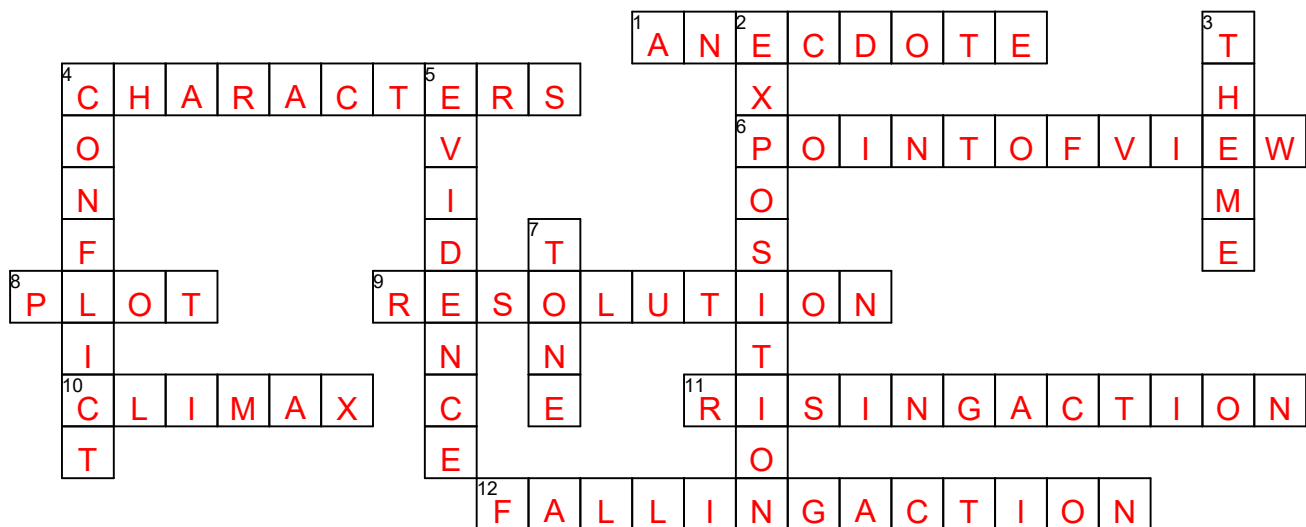

- A related series of incidents in a literary plot that build toward the point of greatest interest.
- The elements of plot after a story's climax and before the resolution.

- The background information of the characters and setting explained at the beginning of the story.
- The message or underlying meaning a writer reveals in a novel, short story, or other literary work.
- A struggle between two opposing forces.
- Text that comes from the story used to support analysis.
- The mood implied by an author's word choices.
