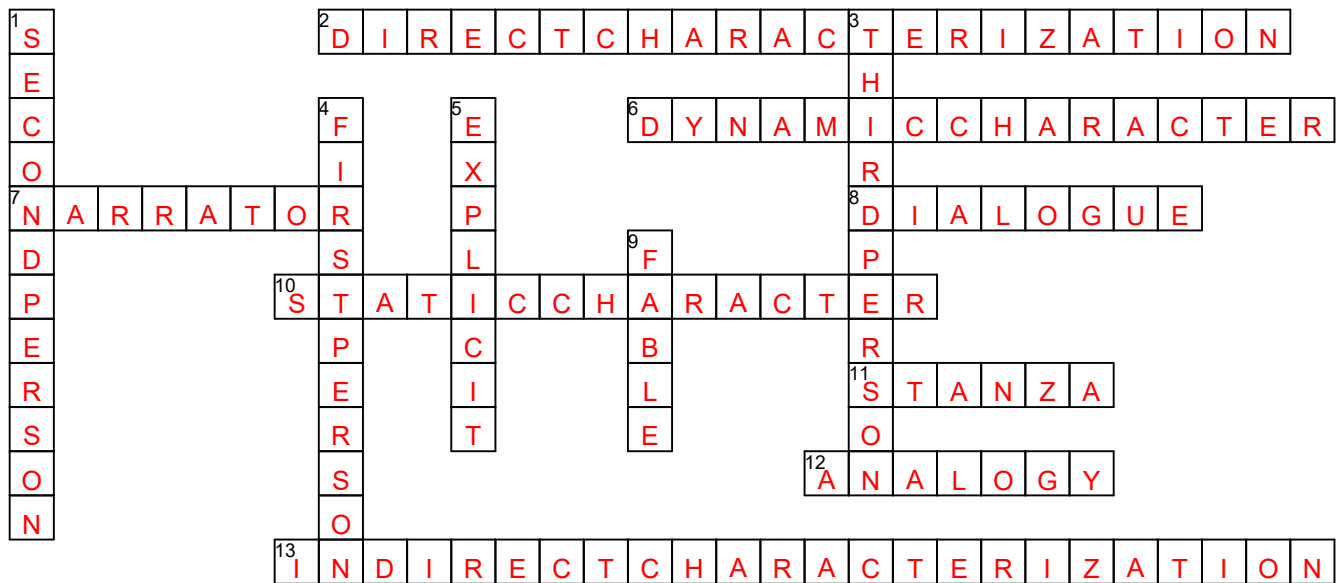


# 4th Grade CCSS Language Arts Terms Crossword Puzzle 6
