8. A conversation between two or more characters.
9. The readers find out about characters through thoughts, comments, or actions of the characters.
10. A character who remains basically unchanged.
11. The narrator or characters in the story tell readers exactly what is needed to know about the characters.
12. A group of lines in a poem that look like a paragraph.
13. A person telling a story.
