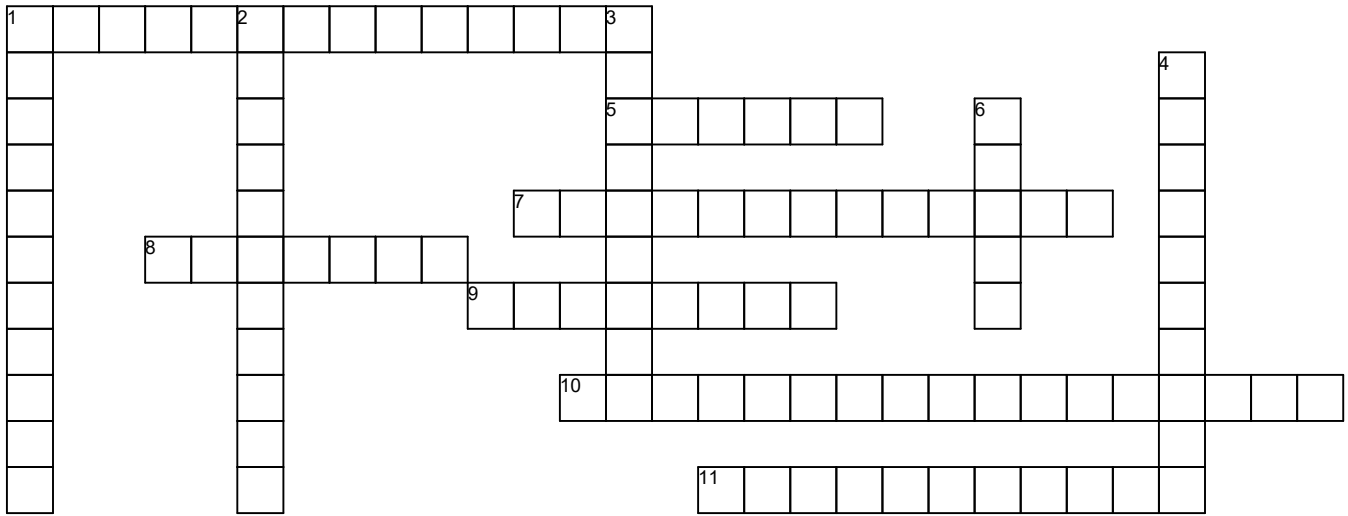


4th Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 19
