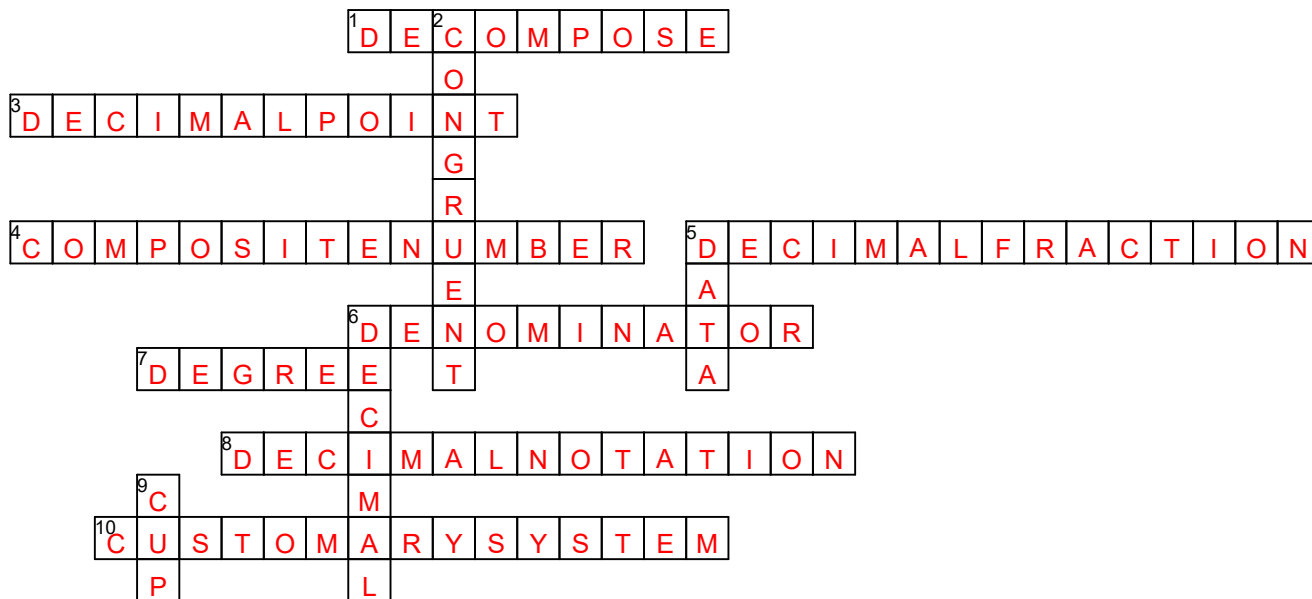


4th Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 3

- The quantity below the line in a fraction. It tells how many equal parts are in the whole.
- A unit for measuring angles based on dividing one complete circle into 360 equal parts.
- A number containing a decimal point.
- A system of measurement used in the United States. The system includes units for measuring length, capacity, and weight.

- Having exactly the same size and shape.
- A collection of information gathered for a purpose in the form of either words or numbers.
- A number with one or more digits to the right of a decimal point.
- A customary unit of capacity. 8 fluid ounces.
