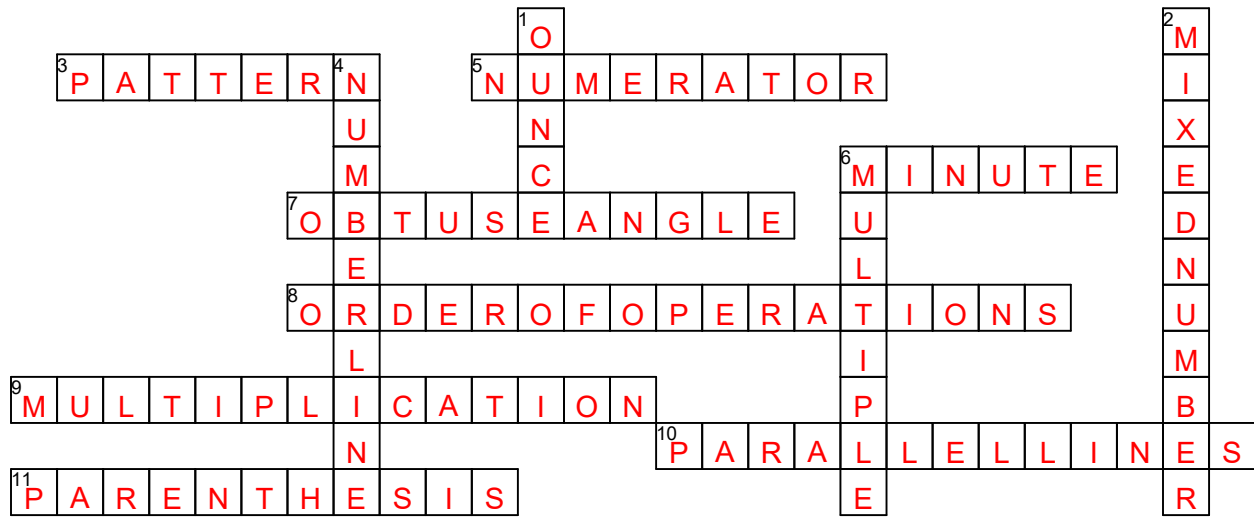


4th Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 30
