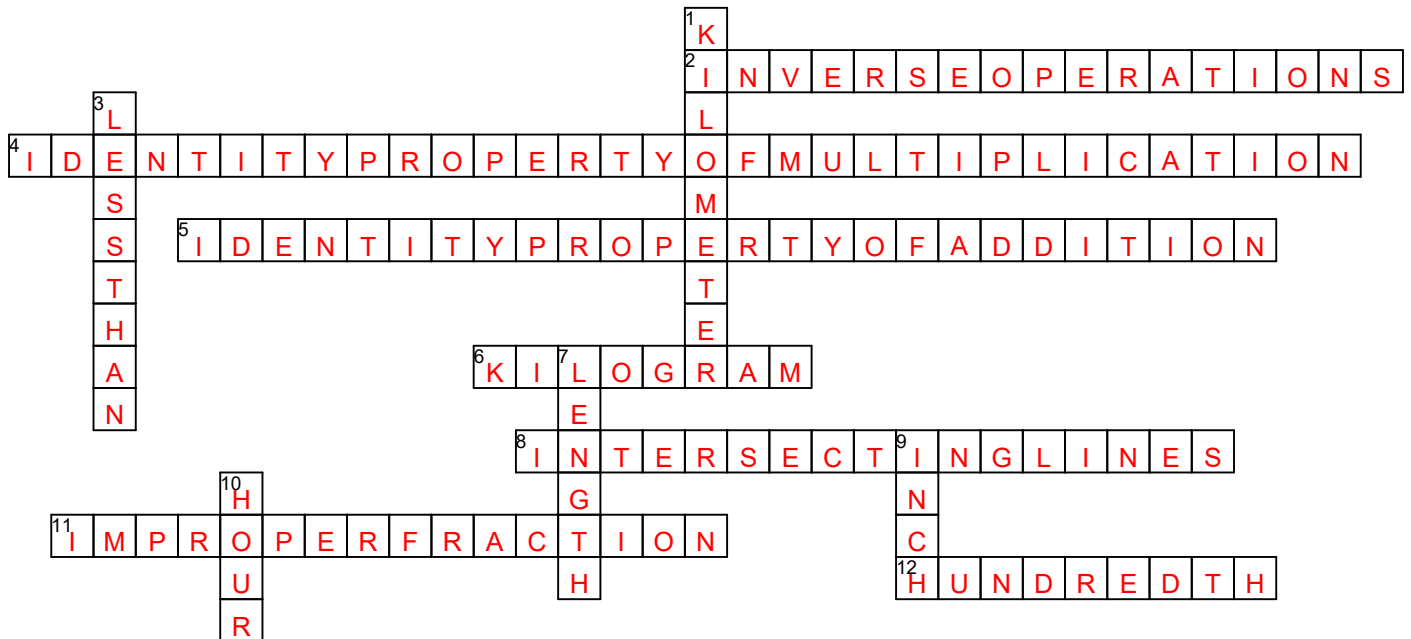


# 4th Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 6

## ACROSS

- A term used for a fraction whose numerator is greater than or equal to its denominator.
- One of the equal parts when a whole is divided into 100 equal parts.

- A metric unit of length equal to 1,000 meters.
- Used to compare two numbers when the first number is smaller than the second number.
- How long something is. The distance from one point to another measured in units such as inches, feet, centimeters, etc.
- A customary unit of length equal to 1/12 of a foot.
- A unit of time equal to 60 minutes.
