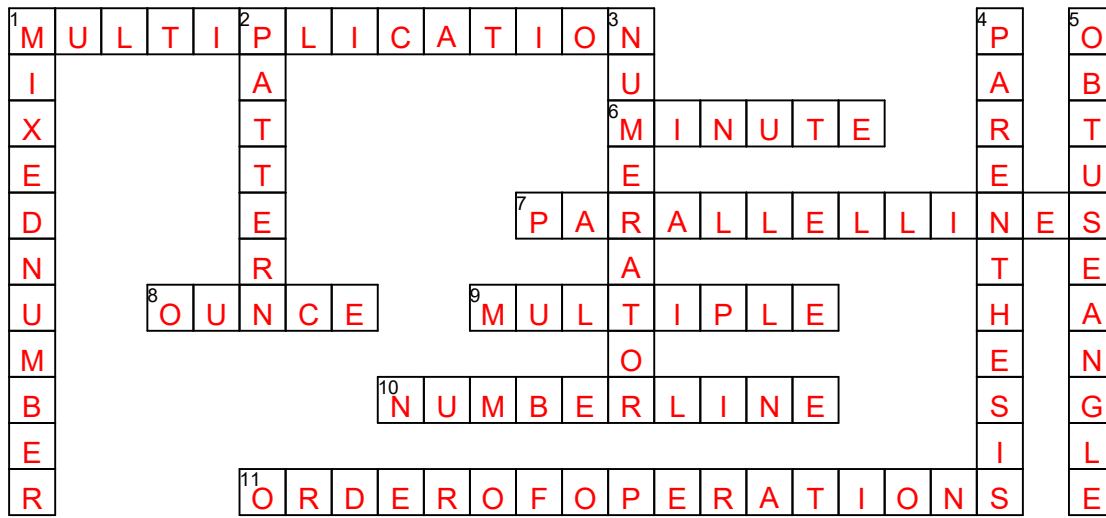


4th Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 8

10. A diagram that represents numbers as points on a line.
11. A set of rules that tells the order in which to compute (PEMDAS).

1. A number that has a whole number (not 0) and a fraction.
2. A repeating or growing sequence or design. An ordered set of numbers or shapes arranged according to a rule.
3. The number written above the line in a fraction. It tells how many equal parts are described in the fraction.
4. Used in mathematics as grouping symbols for operations. ()
5. An angle with a measure greater than 90° but less than 180°.
