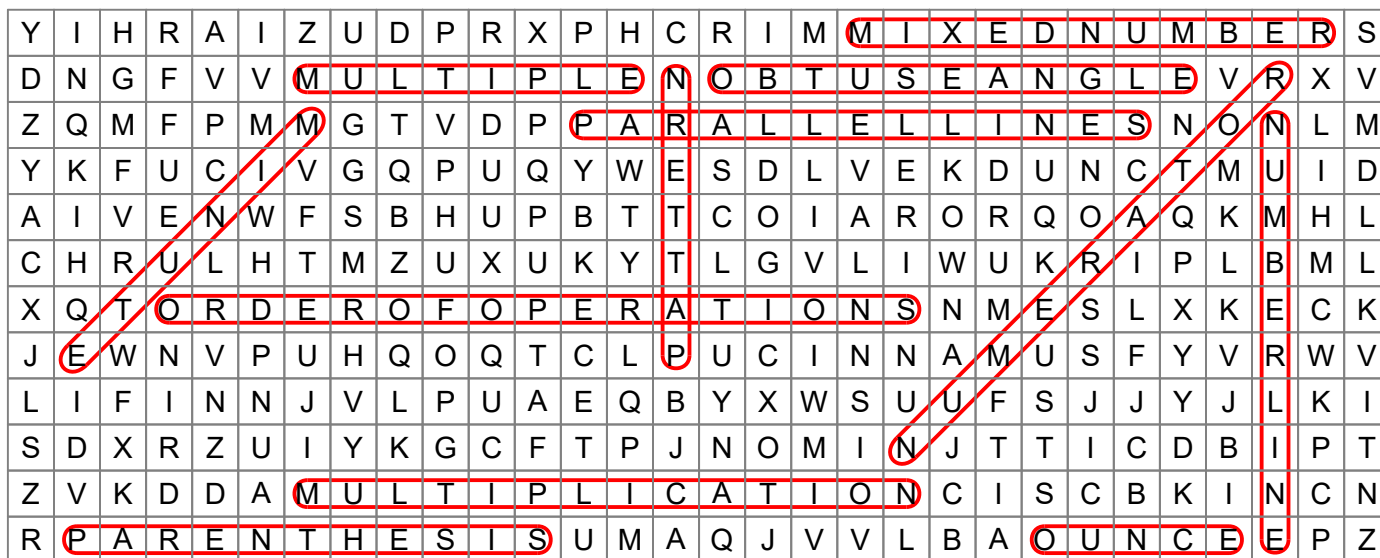


# 4th Grade CCSS Math Word Search Puzzle 30
