| 1. acute angle | An angle with a measure of less than 90° . |
| 2. add | To join two or more numbers or quantities to get one number called the sum or total. |
| 3. additive comparisons | Problems that ask how much more (or less) one amount is than another. |
| 4. algorithm | A way of setting out a step-by-step mathematical procedure. |
| 5. angle | Two rays that share an endpoint. |
| 6. angle measure | It tells how far one side is turned from the other side. |
| 7. arc | Part of a circle between any two of its points. |
| 8. area | The measure in square units of the inside of a plane figure. |
| 9. area model | A model of multiplication that shows each place value product. |
| 10. array | An arrangement of objects in equal rows. |
| 11. associative property of multiplication | Changing the groupings of three or more factors does not change the product. |
| 12. associative property of addition | Changing the groupings of three or more addends does not change the sum. |
