1. attribute	A characteristic of an object, such as color, shape, size, etc.
2. benchmark fractions	Fractions that are commonly used for estimation.
3. capacity	Capacity refers to the amount of liquid a container can hold.
4. centimeter	A metric unit of length equal to 0.01 of a meter.
5. circle	A plane figure with all points the same distance from a fixed point called a center.
6. classify	To sort into categories or to arrange into groups by attributes.
7. commutative property of addition	Changing the order of the addends does not change the sum.
8. commutative property of multiplication	Changing the order of the factors does not change the product.
9. common denominator	A common multiple of the denominators of two or more fractions.
10. compare	To decide if one number is greater than, less than, or equal to.
11. comparison bars	Used to represent larger and smaller amounts in a comparison situation. Different lengths of bars are drawn to represent each number.
12. compose	To put together components or basic elements.
