10.	DIRECT CHARACTERIZATION	The narrator or characters in the story tell readers exactly what is needed to know about the characters.
11.	EXPLICIT	Stated clearly and in detail.
12.	INDIRECT CHARACTERIZATION	The readers find out about characters through thoughts, comments, or actions of the characters.
13.	DIALOGUE	A conversation between two or more characters.
14.	ANALOGY	A similarity between like features of two things.
