1. EXPRESSION A mathematical phrase that contains operations, numbers, and/or variables, but doesn't have an equal sign.
2. EXPONENT A mathematical notation indicating the number of times a quantity is multiplied by itself.
3. SOLUTION The explanation or answer for a problem.
4. FACTORIZATION A number written as a product of its factors.
5. INEQUALITY A mathematical expression which shows that two quantities are not equal.
6. ORDER OF OPERATIONS PEMDAS (Parentheses, Exponents, Multiplication/Division left to right, Addition/Subtraction left to right).
7. BRACES A pair of symbols used to enclose sections of an expression. { }
8. EVALUATE To find the value of a numerical or algebraic expression.
9. PAIR A set of two things used together or regarded as a unit.
10. FORMS Three-dimensional objects that have height, length, and width such as spheres, cylinders, cones, cubes, rectangular prisms, and pyramids. Shapes, appearances, or arrangements.
11. SQUARE ROOT A number that when multiplied by itself equals a given number.
12. POINT An exact location in space represented by a dot.
13. COEFFICIENT A number in front of a variable.
14. OPERATION A mathematical process applied to solve a problem.
15. INVERSE OPERATIONS Operations that undo each other.
16. RELATIONSHIP The ways that two things are similar, different, or otherwise connected. An association between two or more variables.
