1. QUOTIENT The answer to a division problem.
2. BILLION The number that is represented as a one followed by 9 zeros (1,000,000,000).
3. FRACTION A part of a whole expressed using a numerator and a denominator.
4. DIVIDEND The number that is to be divided in a division problem.
5. DIVISOR The number you are dividing by.
6. SUBTRAHEND A number that is subtracted from another number.
7. ORDINAL NUMBER A number that tells the position of something in a list: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th etc.
8. MINUEND The number that is subtracted from.
9. PATTERN A repeating arrangement of shapes, colors, numbers, etc.
10. TRILLION The number that is represented as a one followed by 12 zeros (1,000,000,000,000).
11. DIGIT Any one of the ten symbols 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 used to write numbers.
12. MILLION The number that is represented as a one followed by 6 zeros (1,000,000).
13. DECIMAL A number less than a whole number.
14. SUM The total when numbers are added.
15. MULTIPLICAND The first number in a multiplication problem. The number being multiplied.
16. DIFFERENCE The answer to a subtraction problem.
