1. narrator A person telling a story. The narrator is a person in the story telling the story from their own 2. first person point of view. The narration usually utilizes the pronoun "I." Narration that uses the pronoun "you." 3. second person 4. third person The narrator exists outside the events of the story, and relates the actions of the characters by referring to their names or by the thirdperson pronouns "he", "she", or "they." 5. stanza A group of lines in a poem that look like a paragraph. 6 static character A character who remains basically unchanged. 7. dynamic character A character who undergoes an important change. 8. explicit Stated clearly and in detail. 9. direct characterization The narrator or characters in the story tell readers exactly what is needed to know about the characters. 10. indirect characterization The readers find out about characters through thoughts, comments, or actions of the characters. 11. fable A brief story in prose or verse that teaches a moral or gives a practical lesson about how to live one's life. 12. dialogue A conversation between two or more characters. 13. idiom An expression, word, or phrase that has a figurative meaning understood by native speakers. 14. analogy A similarity between like features of two things.
