- A customary unit of weight equal to one sixteenth of a pound.
- An angle with a measure greater than 90° but less than 180°.
- A set of rules that tells the order in which to compute. PEMDAS.
- Used in mathematics as grouping symbols for operations. When simplifying an expression, the operations within these are performed first.
- A number that has a whole number (not 0) and a fraction.
- A repeating or growing sequence or design. An ordered set of numbers or shapes arranged according to a rule.
- A metric unit of capacity. 1,000 of these = 1 liter.
- A customary unit of length that equals 5,280 feet
- A system of measurement based on tens. The basic unit of capacity is the liter. The basic unit of length is the meter. The basic unit of mass is the gram.
- A standard unit of length in the metric system.
- The operation of repeated addition of the same number.
- A product made by multiplying two whole numbers larger than 1.
- Lines that are always the same distance apart and don't intersect.
- The distance around the outside of a figure.
- One sixtieth of an hour or 60 seconds.
