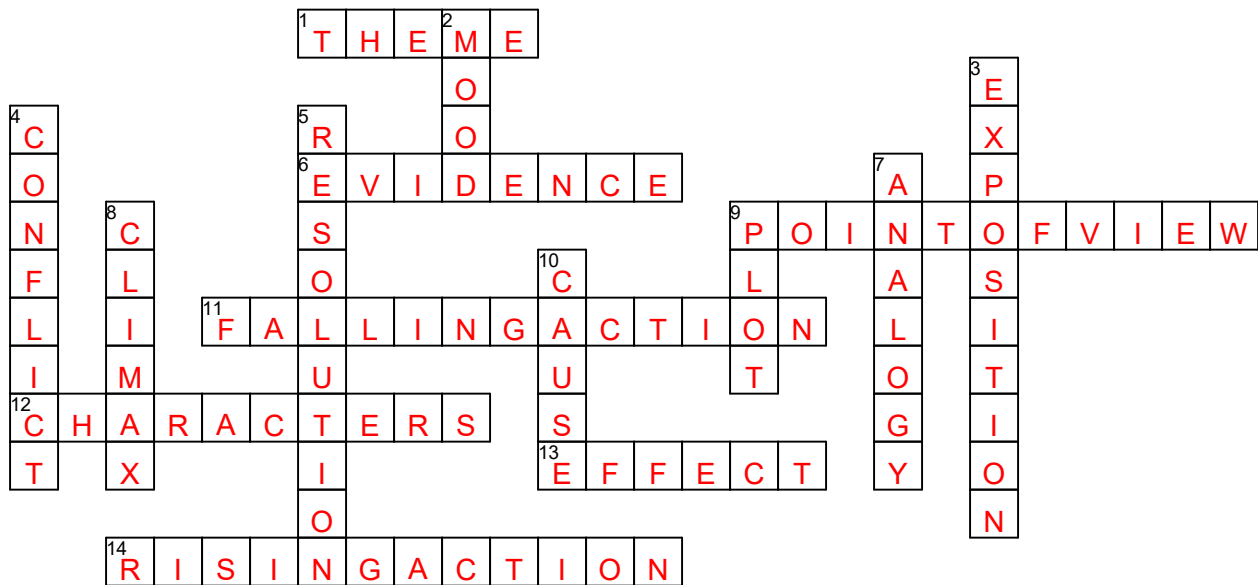

- A similarity between like features of two things.
- The decisive moment or turning point when the rising action of the play is reversed to falling action.
