3.	INDIRECT CHARACTERIZATION	The readers find out about characters through thoughts, comments, or actions of the characters.
4.	NARRATOR	A person telling a story.
5.	THIRD PERSON	The narrator exists outside the events of the story, and relates the actions of the characters by referring to their names or by the third-person pronouns "he", "she", or "they."
6.	STATIC CHARACTER	A character who remains basically unchanged.
7.	DYNAMIC CHARACTER	A character who undergoes an important change.
8.	DIALOGUE	A conversation between two or more characters.
9.	DENOTATION	The literal dictionary definition of a word.
10.	FIRST PERSON	The narrator is a person in the story telling the story from their own point of view. The narration usually utilizes the pronoun "I."
11.	EXPLICIT	Stated clearly and in detail.
12.	STANZA	A group of lines in a poem that look like a paragraph.
13.	CONNOTATION	The feelings and associations that a word suggests.
14.	FABLE	A brief story in prose or verse that teaches a moral or gives a practical lesson about how to live one's life.
15.	SECOND PERSON	Uses the pronoun "you" to address the reader.
