- 4. PERSONIFICATION The attribution of human qualities or capabilities to animals, inanimate objects, or abstract notions.
- 5. SIMILE Using "like" or "as" to make a comparison between two unlike things.
- 6. CENTRAL IDEA What the passage or text is mainly about.
- 7. IDIOM An expression, word, or phrase that has a figurative meaning conventionally understood by native speakers.
- 8. TONE The mood implied by an author's word choices.
