Write the word that best matches each definition or clue.

1. FABLE A brief story in prose or verse that teaches a moral or gives a practical lesson about how to live one's life.
2. CONNOTATION The feelings and associations that a word suggests.
3. STANZA A group of lines in a poem that look like a paragraph.
4. DIALOGUE A conversation between two or more characters.
5. DENOTATION The literal dictionary definition of a word.
6. INDIRECT CHARACTERIZATION The readers find out about characters through thoughts, comments, or actions of the characters.
7. THIRD PERSON The narrator exists outside the events of the story, and relates the actions of the characters by referring to their names or by the third-person pronouns "he", "she", or "they."
8. DIRECT CHARACTERIZATION The narrator or a character in the story tells the readers exactly what is needed to know about the characters.
9. STATIC CHARACTER A character who remains basically unchanged.
10. SECOND PERSON Uses the pronoun "you" to address the reader.
11. EXPLICIT Stated clearly and in detail.
12. NARRATOR A person telling a story.
13. DYNAMIC CHARACTER A character who undergoes an important change.
14. ALLUSION A reference to a statement, a person, a place, or an event from literature, history, religion, mythology, politics, sports, or science.
15. FIRST PERSON The narrator is a person in the story telling the story from their own point of view. The narration usually utilizes the pronoun "I."
