The crossword puzzle grid is composed of empty squares. The numbered starting points are as follows:

- 1: 15 squares down, starting from the top-left.
- 2: 10 squares down, starting from the top-right.
- 3: 10 squares down, starting from the top-right.
- 4: 5 squares across, starting from the middle.
- 5: 8 squares down, starting from the middle-left.
- 6: 6 squares across, starting from the middle-right.
- 7: 5 squares across, starting from the middle-right.
- 8: 3 squares across, starting from the middle.
- 9: 7 squares across, starting from the middle-left.
- 10: 4 squares across, starting from the middle-right.
- 11: 3 squares across, starting from the middle.
- 12: 4 squares across, starting from the middle.
- 13: 10 squares across, starting from the middle-right.
- 14: 14 squares across, starting from the bottom-left.
