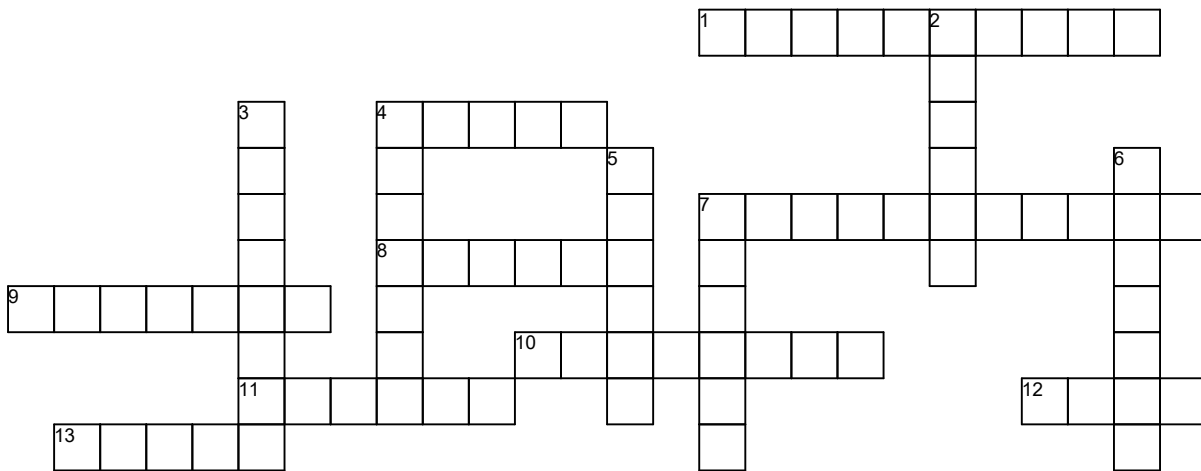


7th Grade Literary Terms Crossword Puzzle 12

8. A musical quality produced by the repetition of stressed and unstressed syllables or by the repetition of certain other sound patterns.

12. The attitude that a writer takes toward the audience, a subject, or a character.
