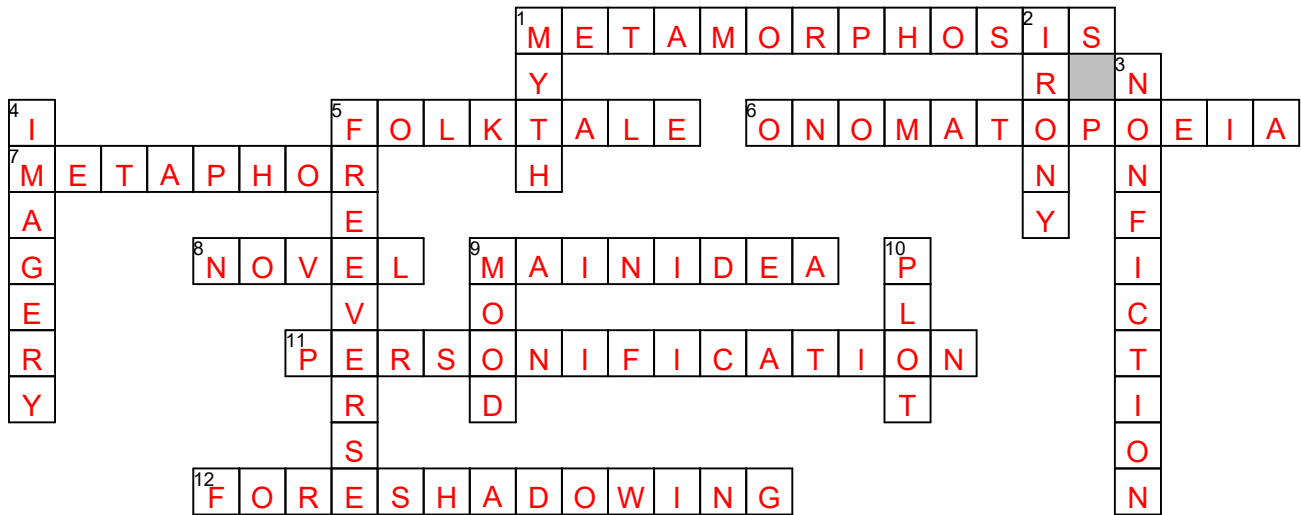


7th Grade Literary Terms Crossword Puzzle 8
