6. Involves the analysis of two variables for the purpose of determining a relationship.
7. One of two equal factors (multiplication) of a number. It is the side of a square.
8. One of three equal factors (multiplication) of a number. It is the side of a cube.
9. Points where a line crosses the x-axis and y-axis.
10. A value much greater or much less than the others in a set of data.
11. An input-output relationship that has exactly one output (y-value) for each input (x-value).
12. A straight line that comes closest to the points on a scatter plot having an equal number of points above and below the line.
13. A function (equation) whose graph is not a straight line.
14. A method of writing very large or very small numbers using powers of 10.
15. The number of cubic units needed to fill a cone.
16. A number that can be expressed as a ratio (fraction) of two integers.
