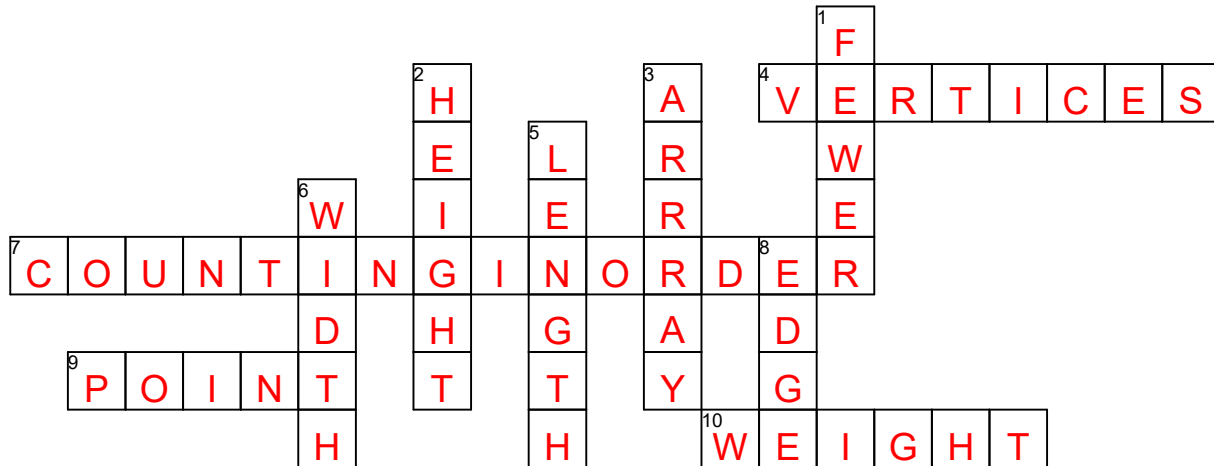


1st Grade CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 15
