8. A punctuation mark (') used to indicate the omission of one or more letters in a word or to indicate possession.
9. A word that takes the place of a noun.
10. Punctuation marks (" or ') used to enclose direct quotations or to designate titles of short works.
11. A word made of two or more word roots.
