- A shortened form of a word. An apostrophe usually represents the missing letters.
- A word made of two or more word roots.
- A complete word all by itself although other word parts may be added to it to make new words.
- A syllable or word that comes before a root word to change its meaning.
- Punctuation marks (" or ') used to enclose direct quotations or to designate titles of short works.
- A word that represents a person, place, thing, or idea.
- A word often used to describe or indicate an action.
- A word that takes the place of a noun.
- A syllable or word that is added at the end of a root word to change its meaning.
- A word that modifies a noun or pronoun by describing it.
