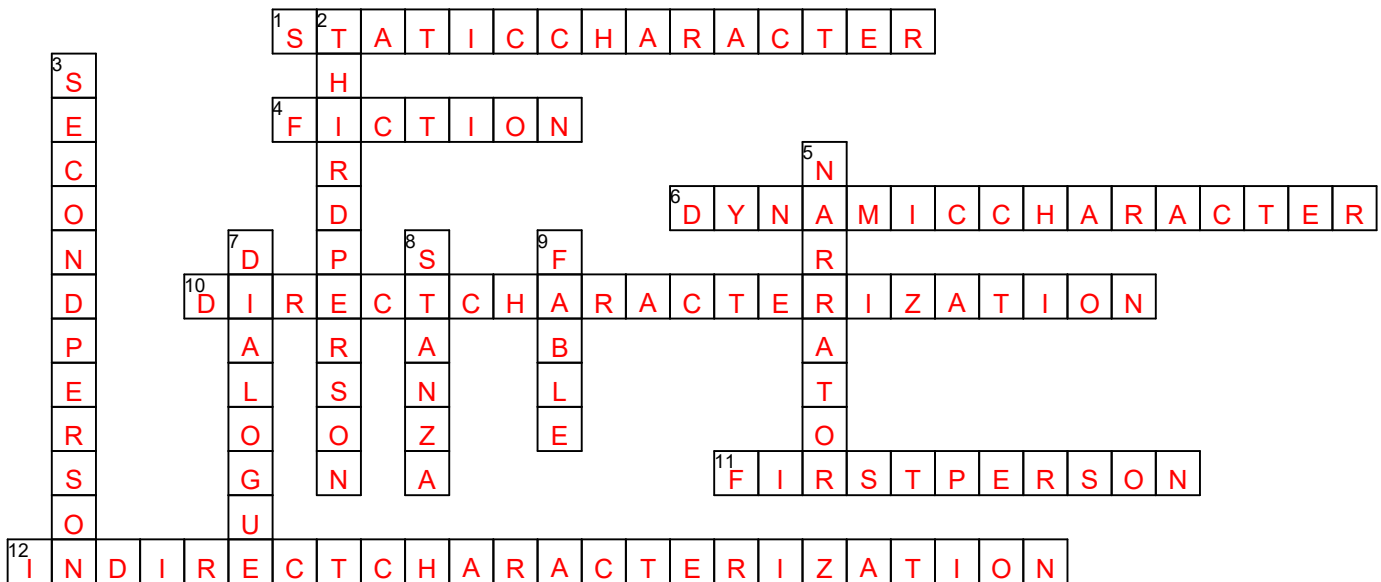


# 3rd Grade CCSS Language Arts Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 16
