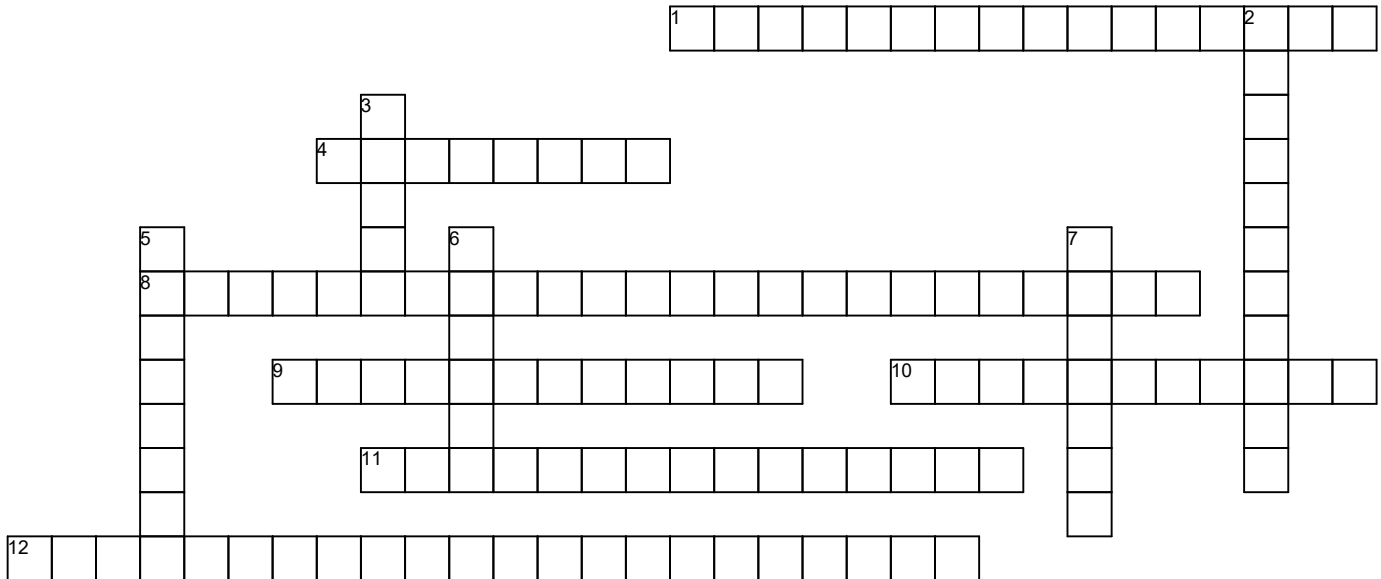


3rd Grade CCSS Language Arts Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 2

1. A character who undergoes an important change.

11. A character who remains basically unchanged.

2. The narrator exists outside the events of the story, and relates the actions of the characters by referring to their names or by the third-person pronouns "he", "she", or "they."

6. A group of lines in a poem that look like a paragraph.
7. A story that is not true or is made up.
