1.	noun	A word that represents a person, place, thing, or idea.
2.	verb	A word often used to describe or indicate an action.
3.	adjective	A word that modifies a noun or pronoun by describing it.
4.	pronoun	A word that takes the place of a noun.
5.	base word	A complete word all by itself although other word parts may be added to it to make new words.
6.	compound word	A word made of two or more word roots.
7.	prefix	A syllable or word that comes before a root word to change its meaning.
8.	suffix	A syllable or word that is added at the end of a root word to change its meaning.
9.	apostrophe	A punctuation mark (') used to indicate the omission of one or more letters in a word or to indicate possession.
10.	contraction	A shortened form of a word. An apostrophe usually represents the missing letters.
11.	quotation marks	Punctuation marks (" or ') used to enclose direct quotations or to designate titles of short works.
12.	analogy	A similarity between like features of two things.
