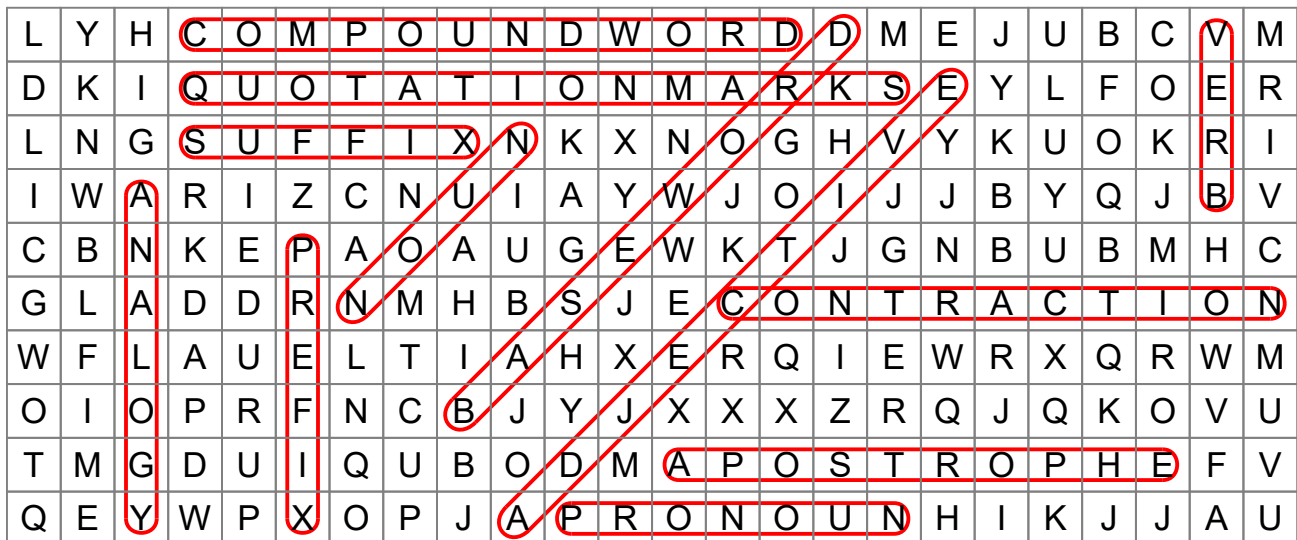

8. A word made of two or more word roots.
9. A complete word all by itself although other word parts may be added to it to make new words.
10. A word often used to describe or indicate an action.
11. Punctuation marks (" or ') used to enclose direct quotations or to designate titles of short works.
12. A syllable or word that is added at the end of a root word to change its meaning.
