7. A complete word all by itself although other word parts may be added to it to make new words.
8. A word that represents a person, place, thing, or idea.
9. A syllable or word that comes before a root word to change its meaning.
10. A word that modifies a noun or pronoun by describing it.
11. A word that takes the place of a noun.
12. A syllable or word that is added at the end of a root word to change its meaning.
