- 12. <u>NOVEL</u> A fictional story that is usually more than one hundred book pages long.
- 13. MOOD The overall emotion created by a work of literature.
- 14. **FORSHADOWING** The use of clues to suggest events that will happen later in the plot.
- 15. **IMAGERY** Language that appeals to the senses.
