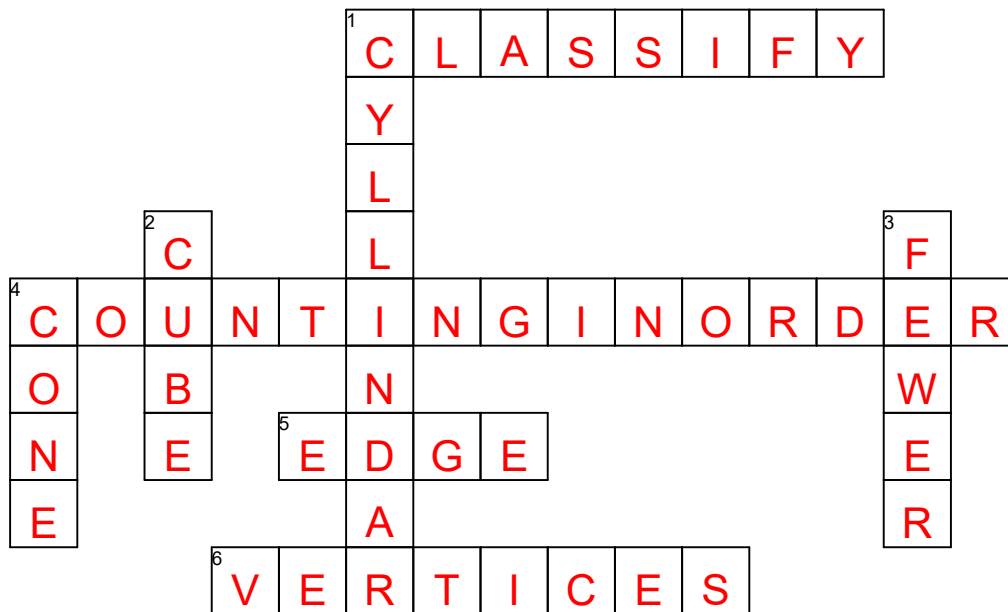


Kindergarten CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 20
