


Kindergarten CCSS Math Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 4

ACROSS

- Being 2-dimensional (length, width).
- Less than the one being compared.
- An individual surface on a 3-dimensional (3D) shape.
- One of the lines that make a flat shape. One of the surfaces that make a solid shape.
