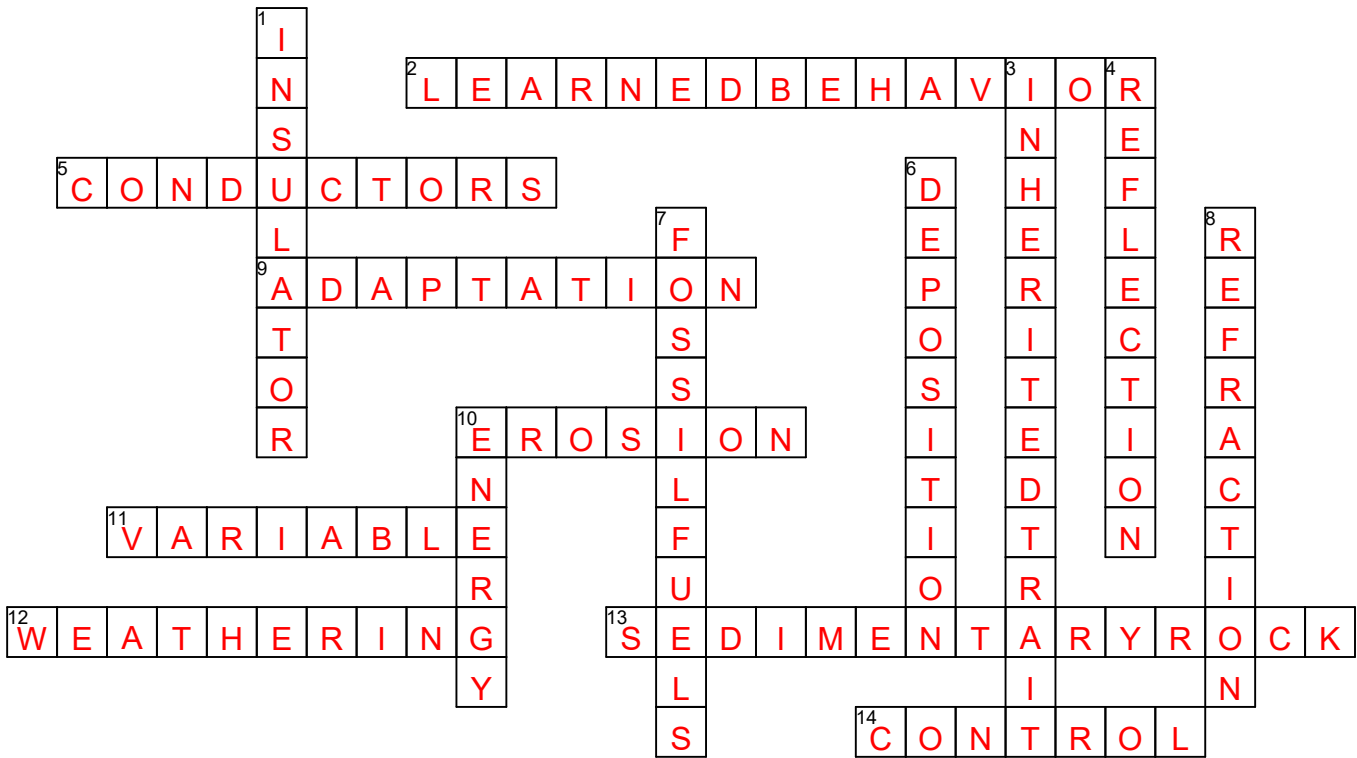


5th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 11
