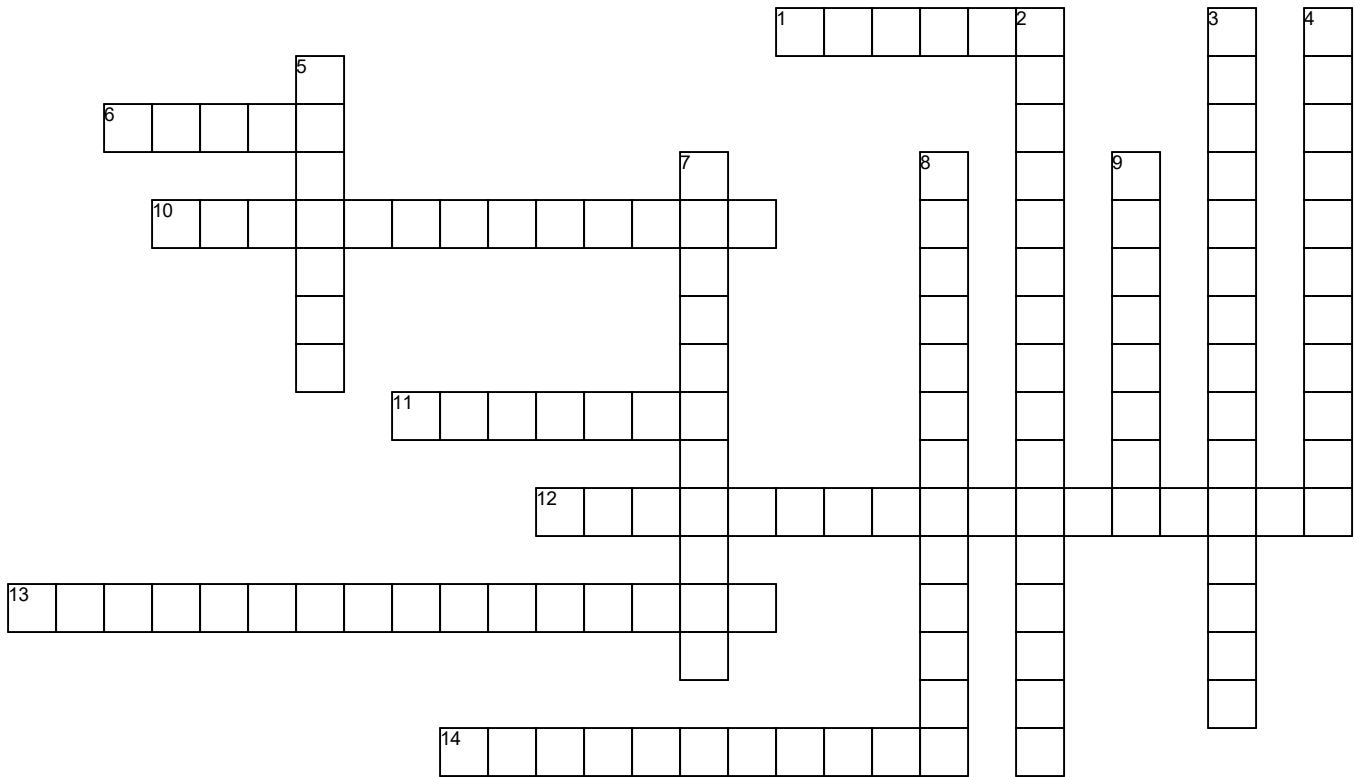


5th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 8
