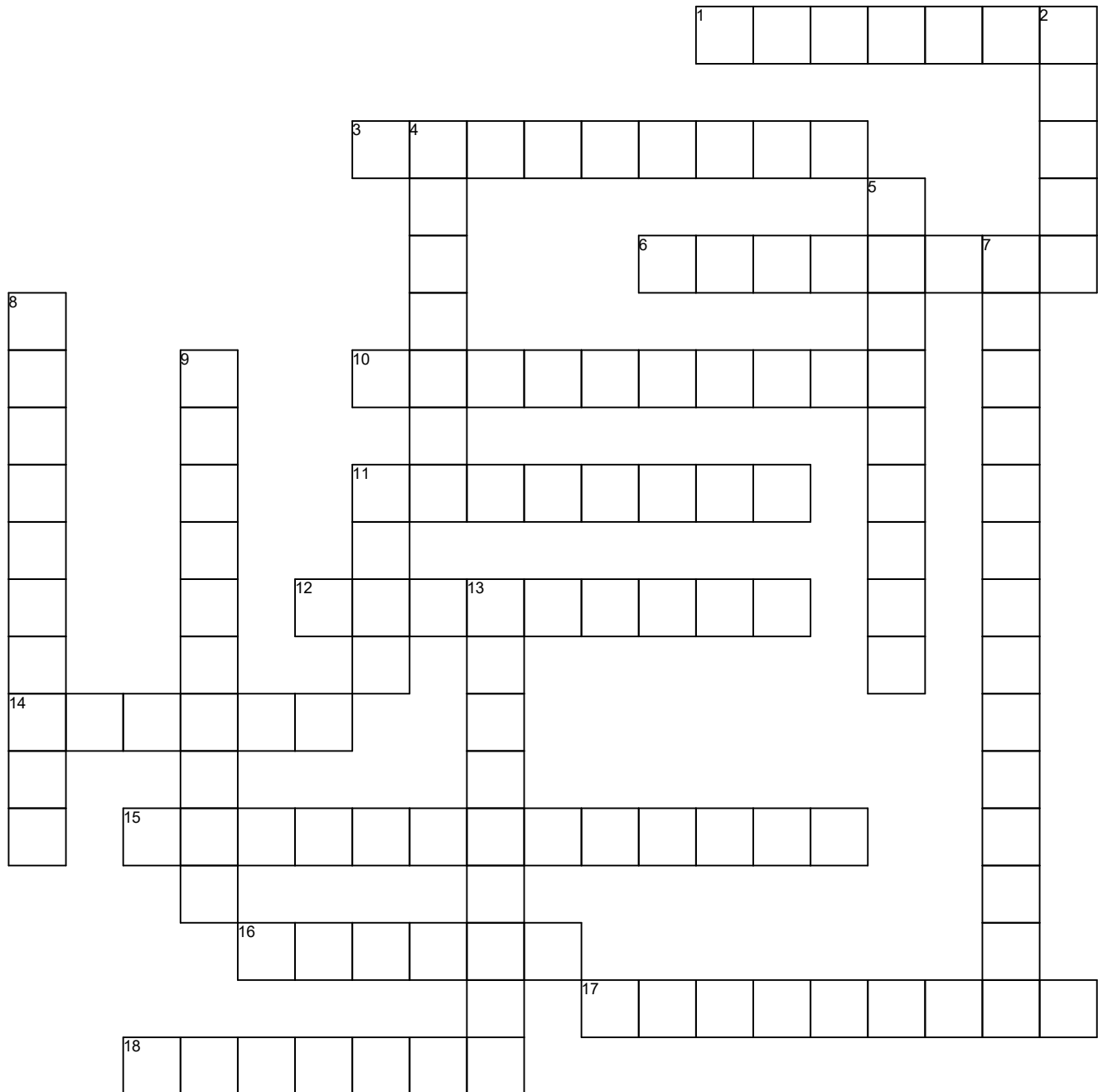


Animal Life Cycles Crossword Puzzle 4
