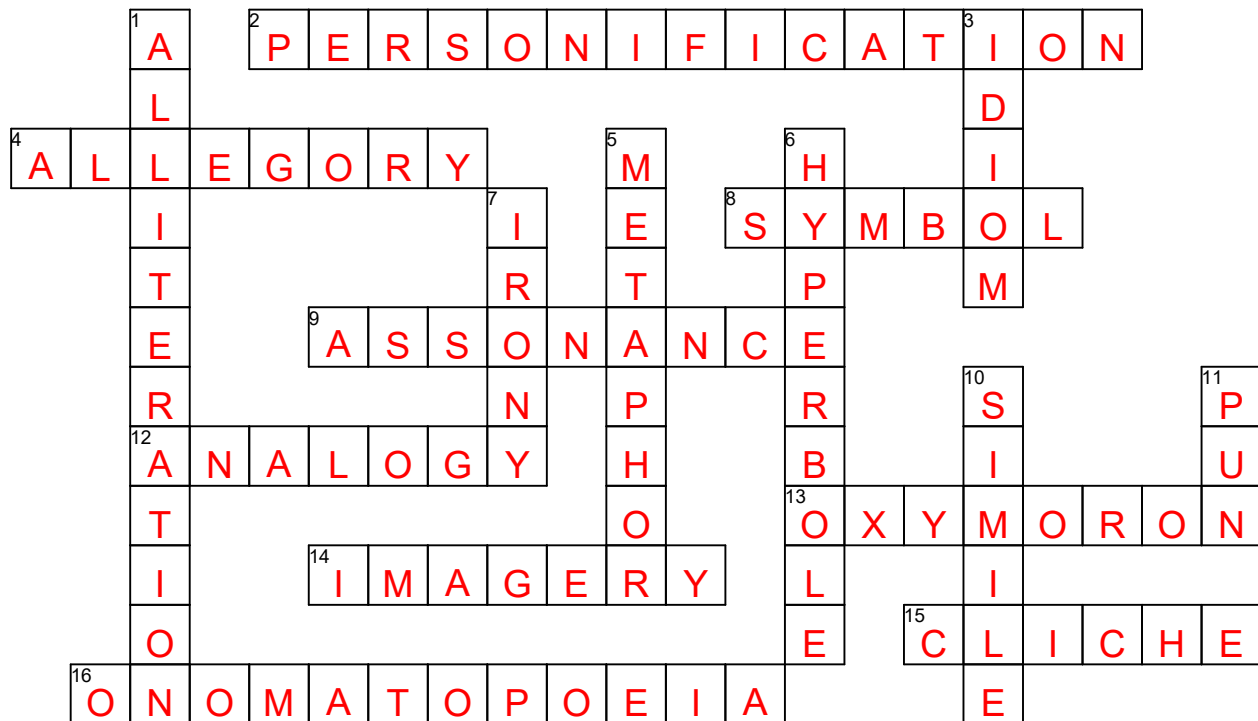


## Figurative Language Crossword Puzzle 2
