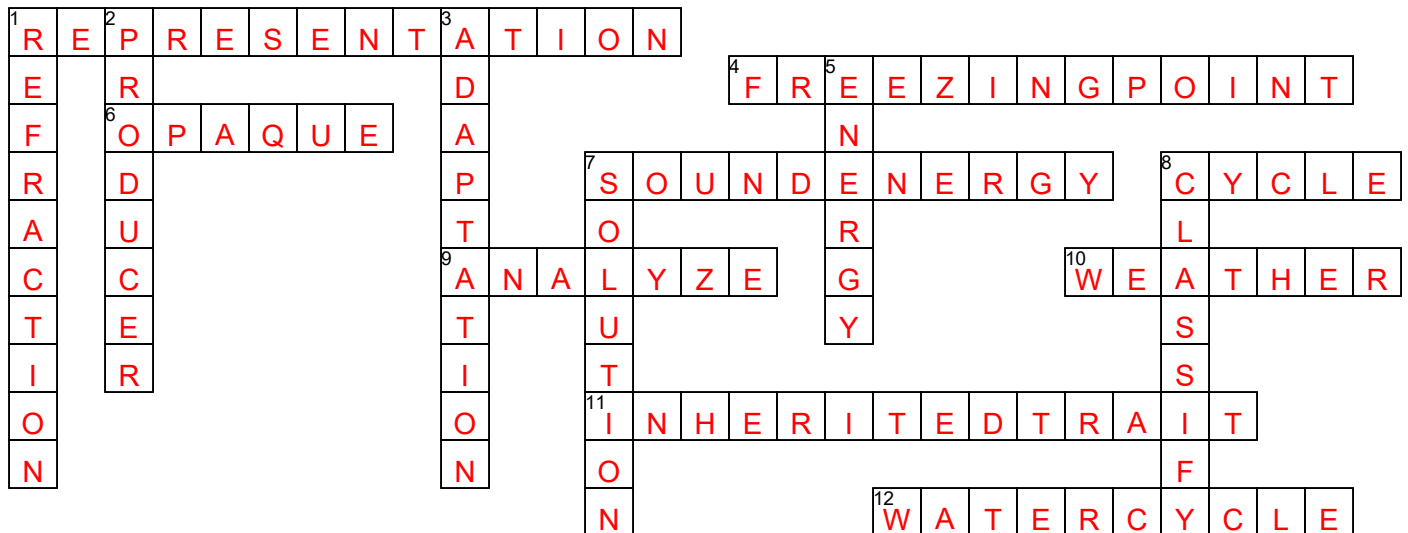


5th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle Review 6

ACROSS

- A sign or symbol that stands for something else.

- Energy that uses vibrations to create sound.

- To examine something by breaking it down to focus on its parts or components.
- The day-to-day conditions in a particular place that include precipitation, temperature, air pressure, and wind.
- A trait passed on from one generation to another such as eye color or hair color.
- The Sun's energy makes water evaporate into the air; water returns to the ground as rain or snow; the process repeats over and over again.

DOWN

- The bending of light when it passes from one substance into a different substance.
- An organism that makes its own food using energy from the sun through a process called photosynthesis.
- A change in the body or behavior of a species over a long period of time to help it survive in its environment.
- The ability to do work or cause changes in matter.
- A mixture of two or more substances dissolved to form one substance and is often difficult to separate.
- To sort into groups by characteristic or property.
