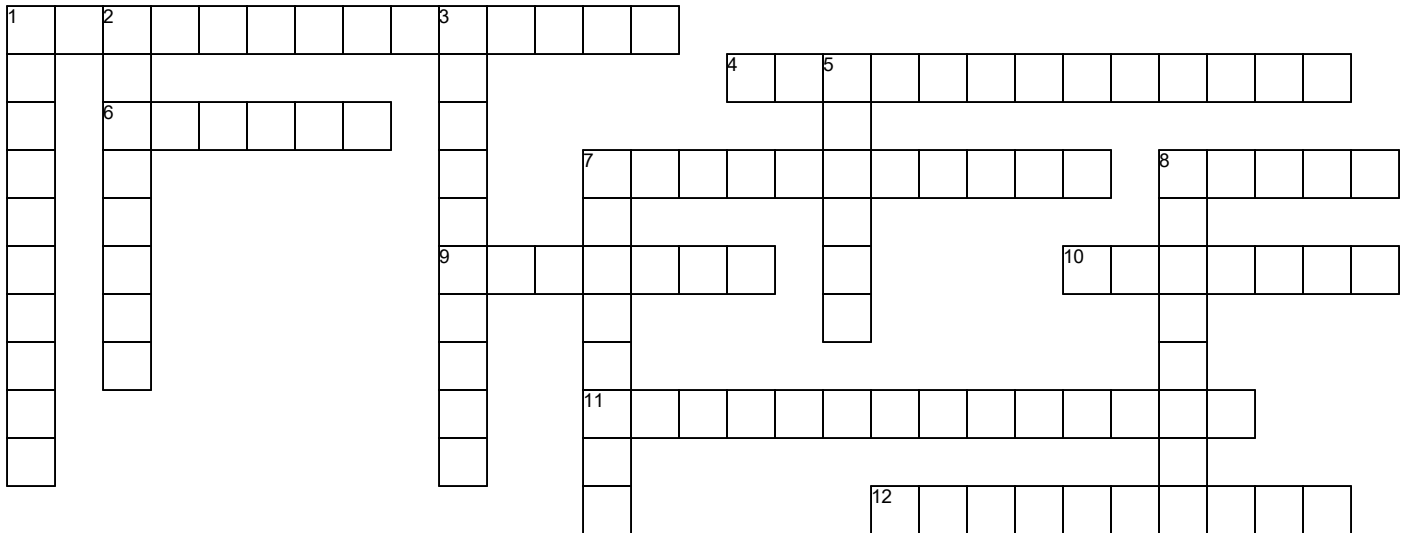


5th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle Review 6
