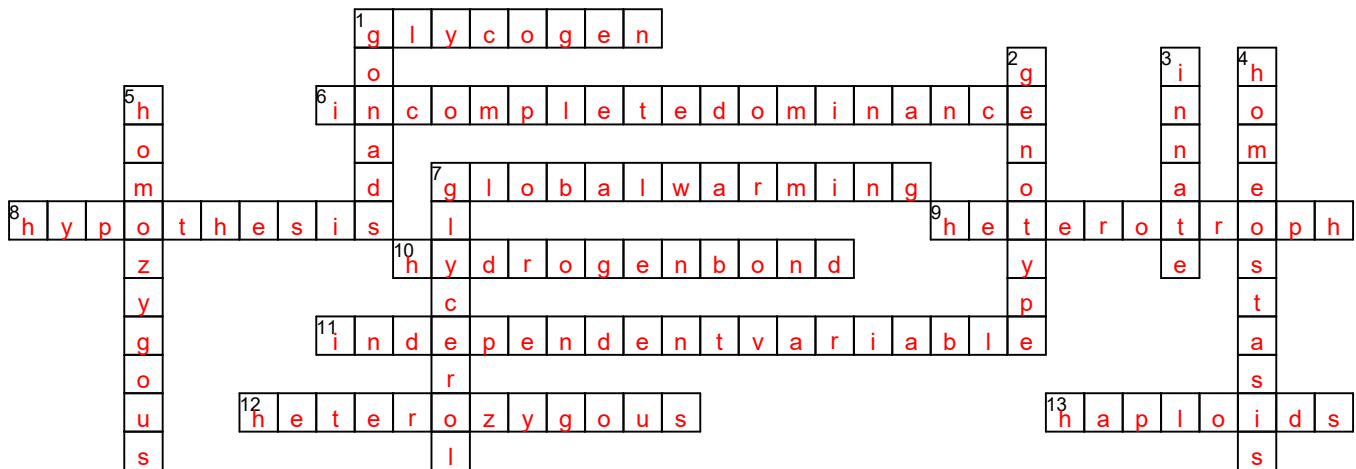


AP Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 25

ACROSS
